At Risk Medication Delivery Program

The Oconee County Sheriff's Office will begin offering free prescription delivery to Oconee County Citizens over the age of 60, citizens currently taking chemotherapy or cancer treatments or those quarantined due to Covid-19. This service is being offered while our state is under a stay at home/work order from our Governor.

Pharmacy Actions

- Verify need of delivery based on guidelines stated.
- Make sure patient knows that they must be at home when prescription is delivered and show an ID
- Obtain payment for prescription.
- Call Oconee County Sheriff's office at 864-638-4117 by 2:30PM each day to let them know a pick up is needed. This is being offered Monday through Friday.
- Make sure contact number for patient is on the outside of the bag in case officer needs to make contact with patient.

*** If special arrangements need to be made regarding payment; let the Sheriff's office representative know ASAP so that we can work on a solution.

Oconee County Sheriff's Office Actions

- An Oconee County Sheriff's Officer will pick up the prescriptions when you notify us that they are ready for pick up.
- Officer will provide their photo ID and sign for the prescriptions.
- Officer will deliver prescriptions to the home address of the patient immediately upon picking them up at the pharmacy.

Patient must be at home to accept delivery and must show photo ID to officer through a clear window so that a photo can be obtained of the photo ID for verification.

Prescriptions will be left outside the door.
